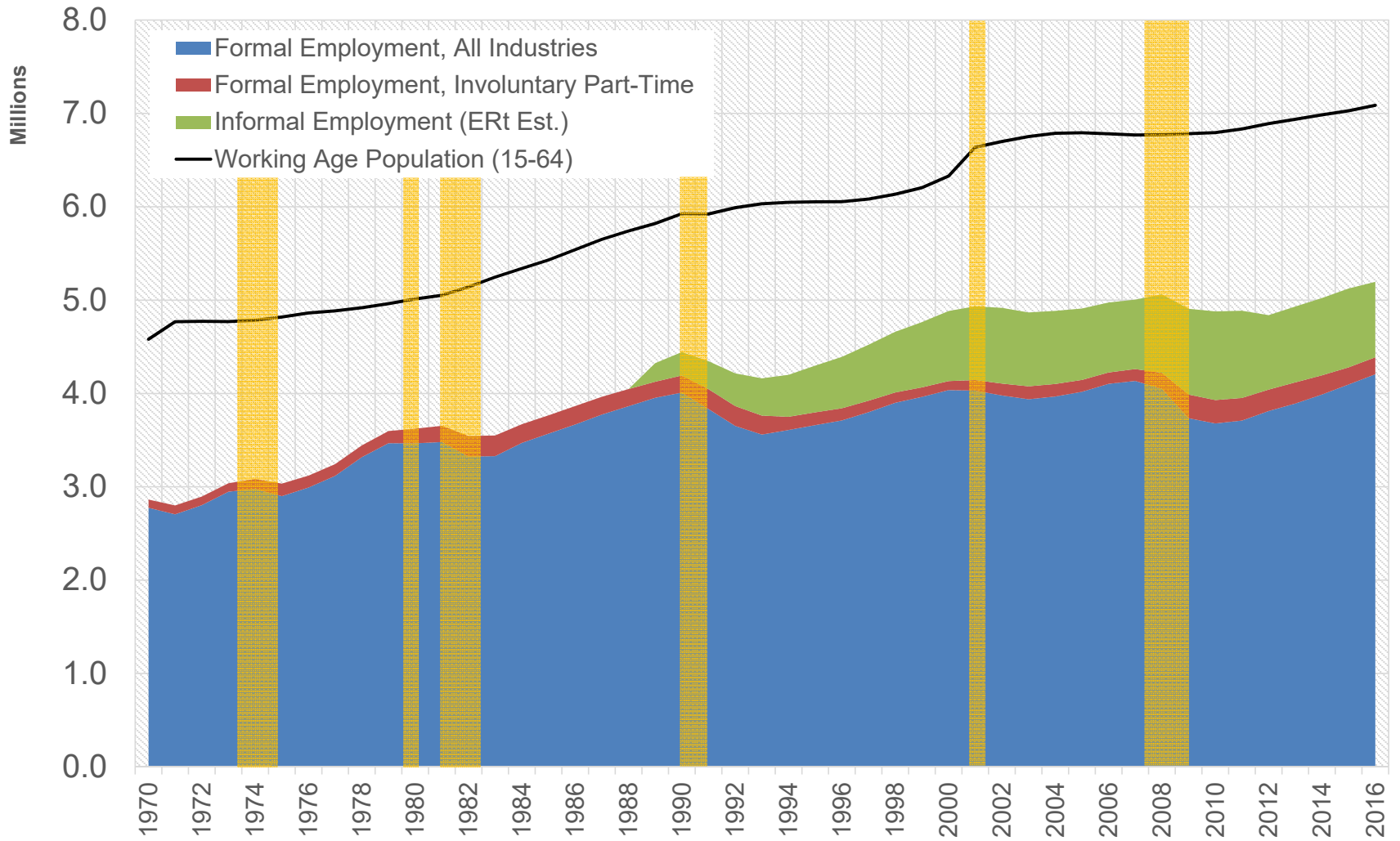

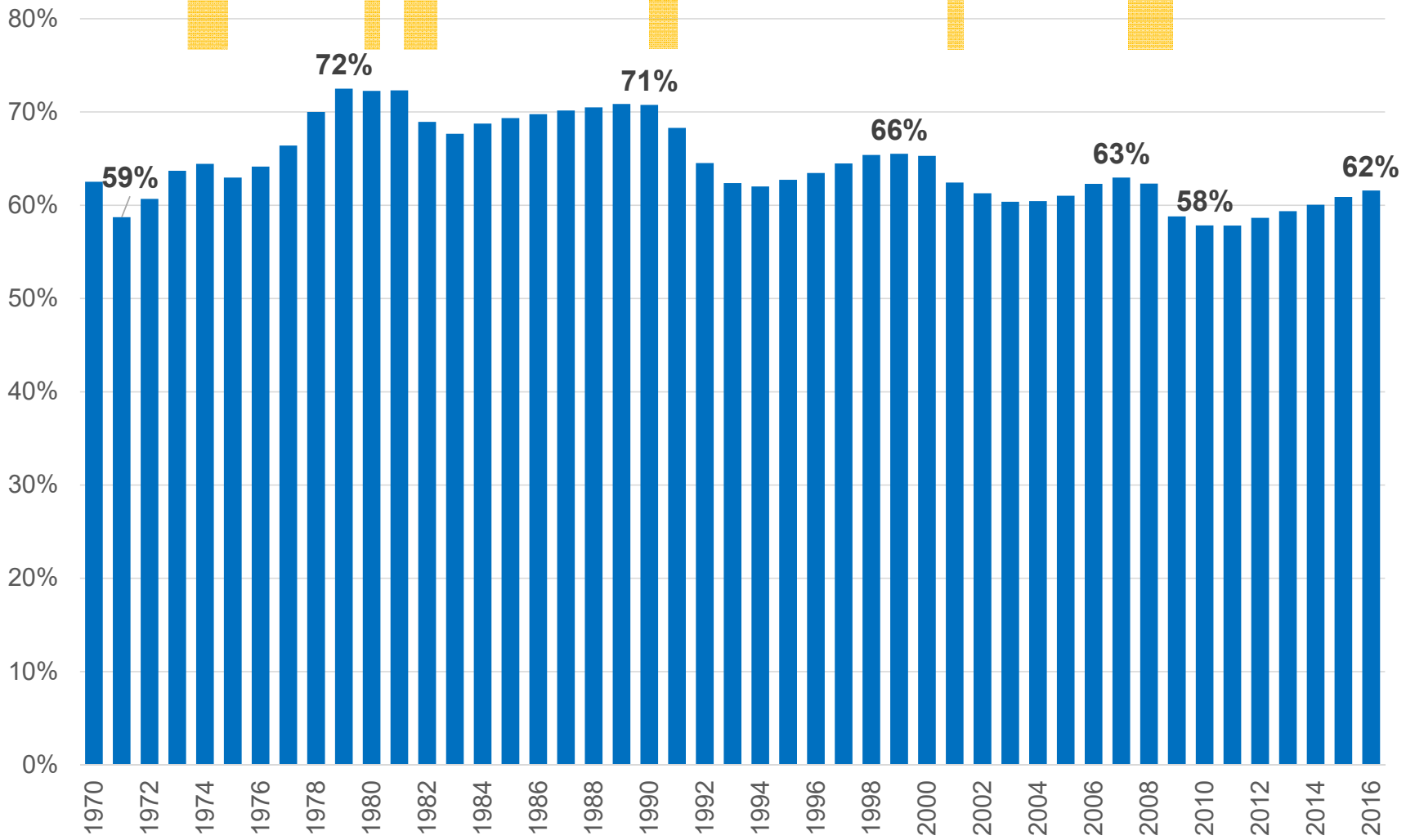
L.A. Co. Employment & Working Age Population (15-64)

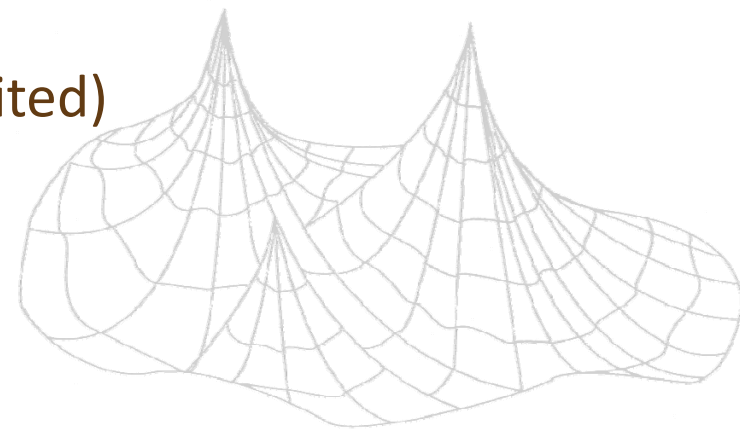
L.A. Co. Ratio of Employment to Working Age Residents



Accessing the Social Safety Net

Work-Based Cash Assistance

- Unemployment Insurance (time-limited)
- State Disability Insurance
- Workers' Compensation Insurance



Cash Assistance:

- General Relief (\$221/mo.)
- TANF (\$714 family of 3)
- SSI (disability; \$733 indiv.)

Cash Equivalent:

- CalFresh (\$511 family of 3)
- W.I.C. (varies by family size)
- Section 8 (\$1,490 1 BR)
- Public Housing
