I am writing to request approval of the procedures for protection of human subjects in the USC Service Worker Research Project that are explained in the attached Request for IRB Approval. The attached application requests that this project be approved for expedited review based on our assessment that the research will pose no greater than minimal risk to human subjects.

We propose to submit reports on protection of human subjects, data security and project design to the IRB semi-annually or more often if requested. Should there be any study-related events that endanger human subjects or compromise data security, these events will be reported immediately to the IRB as well as any organizations whose data is affected.
