



Consent Form for Data Sharing

Training and Employment Project

The three organizations that are the primary service providers in the Training and Employment Project need to share information about you in order to coordinate their services. In addition, the Economic Roundtable needs to use information about project participants for an evaluation of the project's effectiveness.

The three organizations that will share information about you after you sign this consent form are Economic Roundtable, Special Services for Groups and Long Beach City College. Your consent for these organizations to retain shared information about you can be withdrawn at any time without losing any benefits to which you are otherwise entitled.

Information about you will not be shared with anyone outside of these three organizations or used in any way that identifies you to anyone outside of these three organizations. All three organizations have an obligation to protect your confidentiality. Any personal information that could reasonably identify you will be removed or changed before the evaluation is made public.

The three organizations will share the following types of information about you:

- Information about services received in the program;
- Information about participation in program activities;
- Summary information from behavioral health services;
- Transcript information from Long Beach City College;
- Information about post-program academic, housing and employment outcomes.
